ROLE/PURPOSE: We are looking for a skilled Project Manager to join our dynamic team. The position is based at the CIE National Office in Booysens, Johannesburg.

The purpose of the position is to run the Free State Department of Education Literacy and Numeracy Project for a fixed term of 3 years. This involves leading a consortium of Trainers who specialise in training trainers and teachers in foundation phase Home Language Afrikaans and Sesotho as well as Mathematics. Part of the positions key deliverables is to monitor the impact of the training done in schools over guided timelines.

Key responsibilities include:

- Leading and motivating a team of foundation phase education trainers.
- Leading the review and revision of all materials developed by partner organisations and to ensure integration with CAPS and the FSDoE.
- Develop and manage the project plan.
- Drive internal co-ordination of the programme for integration and planning with partner organisations, content specialists and education department officials.
- Co-ordinate and oversee all Train the Trainer sessions with FSDoE.
- Oversee and support day to day operations of the project.
- Track all milestones as per the project plan.
- Ensure project delivery is on time and on budget.
- Developing weekly and monthly monitoring reports for internal use, as well as for funders and the department of education.

ELIGIBILITY: The successful incumbent will possess a recognised degree in Education or Project Management, have strong leadership and communication skills as well as experience in working with provincial education departments. A valid driver's licence, proficiency in MS Suite, project planning tools and report writing skills are all pre-requisites. At least 5 years' experience in Project Management and fluency in Sesotho will be an added advantage.
