GENERAL INFORMATION

- a) This test is offered to Catholic schools throughout South Africa. It aims to encourage Religious Education in the schools, to signal the importance of assessment in Religious Education and to give participating schools some indication of their learners' competence in this field.
- b) The test should be seen as just one form of assessment and is not intended to replace other forms of internal assessment.
- c) The test will be based on the draft National Core RE Curriculum published in January 2016 and distributed through your regional office. The core curriculum can be accessed at <u>http://www.cie.org.za/areas_of_focus/religious_education/curriculum/</u>

The following 32 Lessons from CORD, Grade 9 make up this core:

Prayer Education	3,4,5
Worship Education	1,3,6,8,10
Scriptural Education	3,5,6
Personal Moral Education	2,3,4,7,8
Education in Structural Morality	4,5,6,7

- d) The test will consist of TWO SECTIONS: A. 20 multiple choice questions (40 marks); and B. 4 short questions (60 marks). SECTION A (Multiple Choice) will consist of 5 questions of general knowledge and 15 questions based on the lessons listed in (c).
- e) The questions will be moderated by a panel of Grade 9 teachers in each region.
- f) The recommended time for the test is 1½-2 hours, but schools should be flexible in this regard, taking into account the capacities of the learners. Schools could decide to have learners write Section A and Section B on consecutive days.
- g) The test will be available in English only though second language English speakers will be kept in mind in the framing of questions, and a glossary of terms will be included on the answer sheet in Afrikaans, Setswana, Sesotho, isiZulu and isiXhosa.
- h) The test papers and answer sheets will be available either electronically at no charge, OR in print at an entry fee of R3.50 per learner to cover printing costs and postage.
- i) The test (both Section A and Section B) will be **marked internally by the school** with the aid of memorandums supplied by CIE.
- j) Results will be sent to CIE on completion of marking and an overall report will be made available on request. Results of individual schools will remain confidential.
